Make sure your colours are similar to the 'POP ART' colours used by Andy Warhol

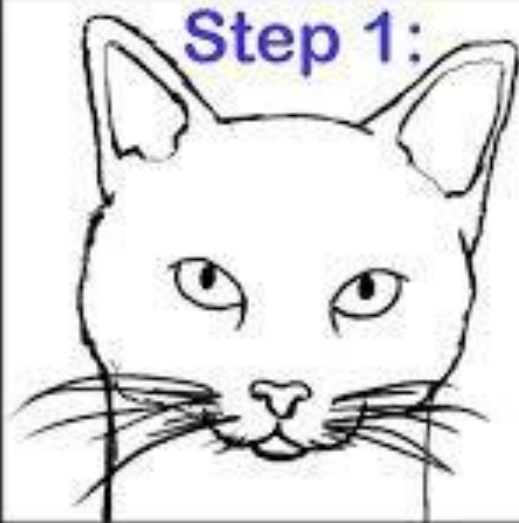


In the space below create your own Onomatopoeia Art

# INSTRUCTIONS:

## Step 1:



Using the Resource Images, make an outline drawing of the cat or the dog. Use a lead pencil. No shading. No details. Leave the background bare.

Page 1

## Step 3:

With a lead pencil, draw a swirling line diagonally across the entire artwork, making sure the loops touch. This will create additional shapes.



## Step 2:



On the animal's face, draw a variety of shapes. Do not make the shapes too small. For the above example, 22 lines were drawn to create 30+ shapes.

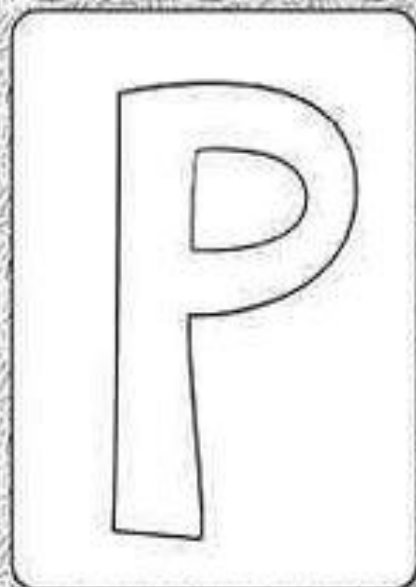


**Step 4:** Colour each shape using water-based markers (textas) or Sharpies. Some shapes should include a pattern.

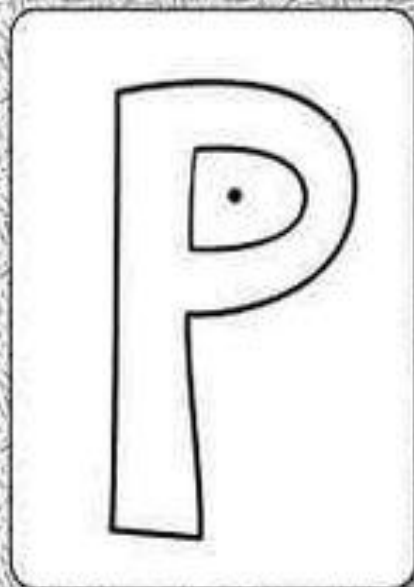
**Step 5:** Using a black marker or Sharpie, trace EVENLY over all the lines created from Step 1, Step 2 and Step 3. Lines around the eyes should be made thicker as this will make them stand out.

# Starburst Letters

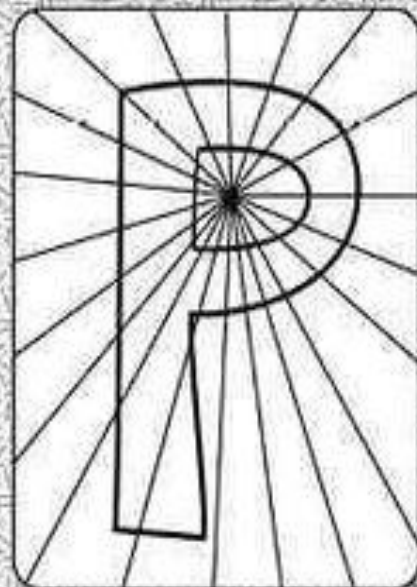
Using lines, shapes and colors to create Op Art.



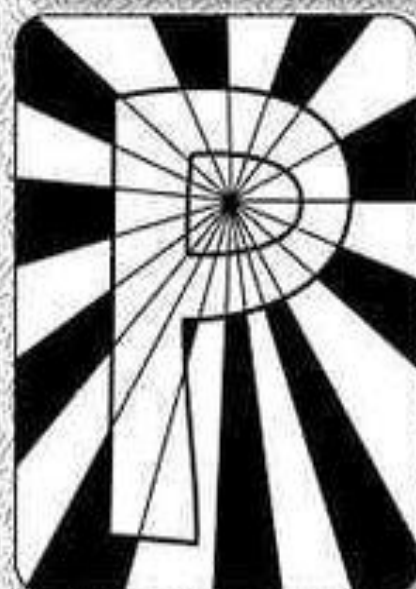
Draw a block letter.  
Erase any stray pencil marks.



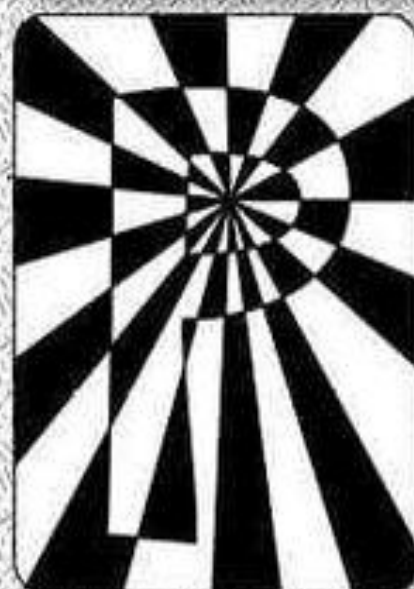
Outline the letter with the first  
color. Put a dot somewhere  
on the page.



Draw an even number of  
lines from the center dot to  
the edge of the paper.



Color every other shape  
around the outside  
of the letter.



Color inside the letter next,  
by using the opposite color  
as the background.



Finish by coloring the  
white areas with a color that  
contrasts with the first color.
