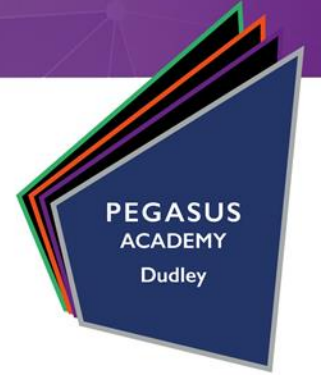

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General Entry Requirements
To study A levels, you will require a minimum of 5 GCSEs including two at grade 6 and three at grade 5. English language must be at a minimum of grade 4.
Individual subjects may have specific entry requirements (see courses for details).

Public Services BTEC Diploma - Level 3

Entry Requirements

You should have one of the following qualifications: Diploma: • 4 GCSEs at grade 4 or above to include English and Maths.
Extended Diploma: • 5 GCSEs at grade 4 or above to include English and maths.

Computer Science

You will require a grade 6 or higher in maths, in addition to the general entry requirements.

Sport and Physical Education

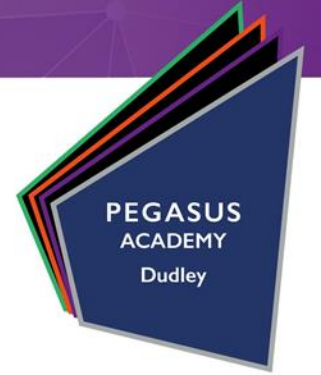
You will require a grade 6 in a science (preferably biology), in addition to the general entry requirements.

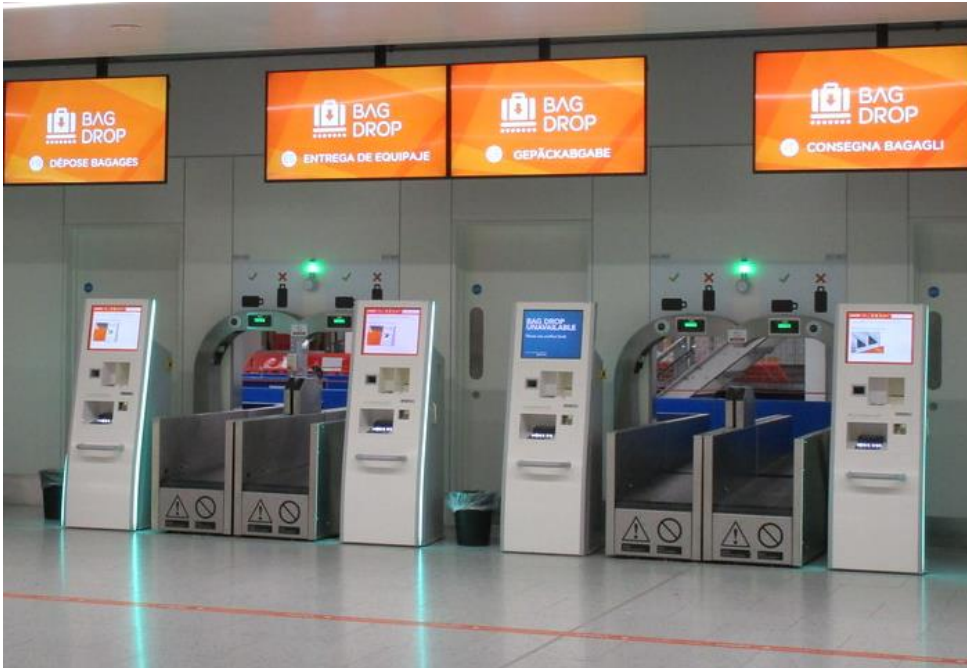
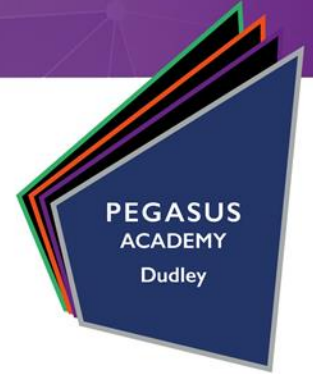
You will require a grade 6 in English and a grade 6 in history, in addition to the general entry requirements.

Jess's Tips to Turn Lost Marks into Gained



When it comes to getting back our marks we tend to be really good at concentrating on it and did well and not so good at facing the areas we lost marks. This was certainly the case in my final year of school. The thing we all realise is that these mistakes are actually the future success in our real exams. Understand where we went wrong and why, regaining those lost marks a whole lot. Figuring this out completely changed my attitude to study in my final year and had a huge impact on my final mark. Have a look below to see the tips I used to use. And remember, it works for you and practice questions as well as your mock exams.

Step 1: Where did those marks go?

- Go through and look at your teacher's marking
- Make a list of the questions that you got wrong

Step 2: How do I get those marks back?

- Look through your subject notes and see if you can correct the questions you got wrong
- Speak to your teacher about any questions where you don't know what the marks
- Your teacher can tell you exactly what you need to do to get them back

Step 3: Record

- Create a document where you store all your weak spots in each subject and the correct answers to questions about them
- I save this and call it my 'Bullet-Proof Booklet' - because it makes my exam bullet proof!

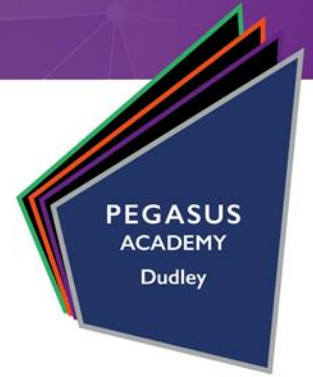

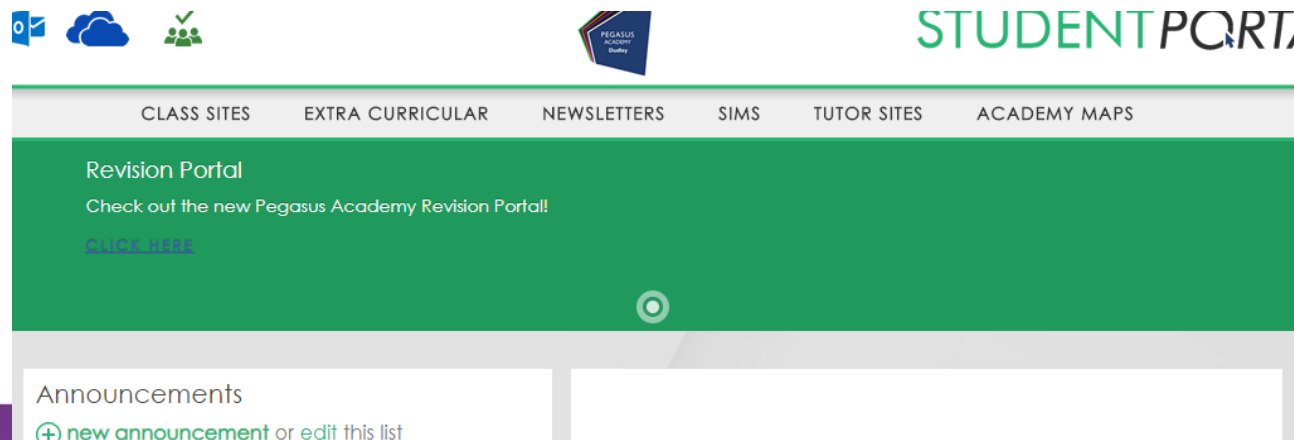

How To Access The Portal

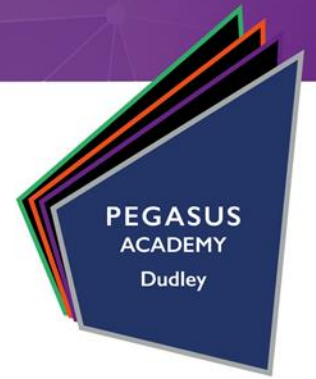


- Go to the Academy website www.pegasusacademy.org.uk

- The link for the revision portal will be in the top slider bar.



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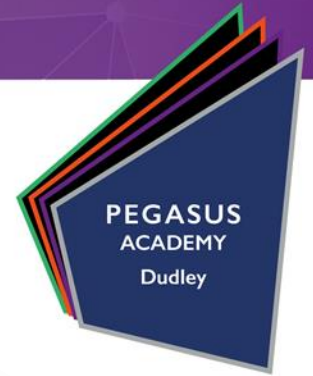




Email Account
