





Public Services BTEC Diploma - Level 3

Entry Requirements

You should have one of the following qualifications: Diploma: • 4 GCSEs at grade 4 or above to include English and Maths. Extended Diploma: • 5 GCSEs at grade 4 or above to include English and maths.

Computer Science

You will require a grade 6 or higher in maths, in addition to the general entry requirements.

Sport and Physical Education

You will require a grade 6 in a science (preferably biology), in addition to the general entry requirements.

History

You will require a grade 6 in English and a grade 6 in history, in addition to the general entry requirements.







- -The link for the revision portal will be in the top slider bar.






